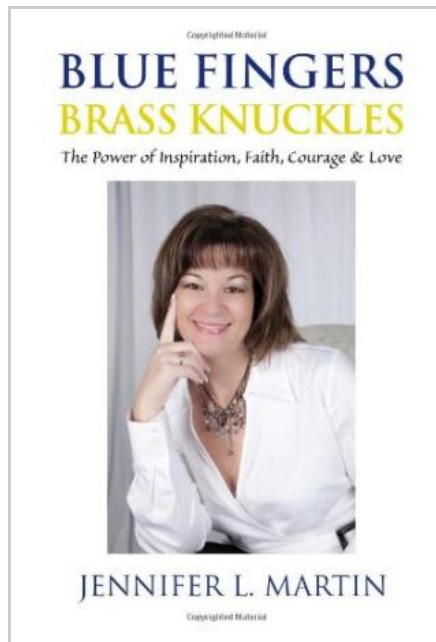




Blue Fingers Brass Knuckles
