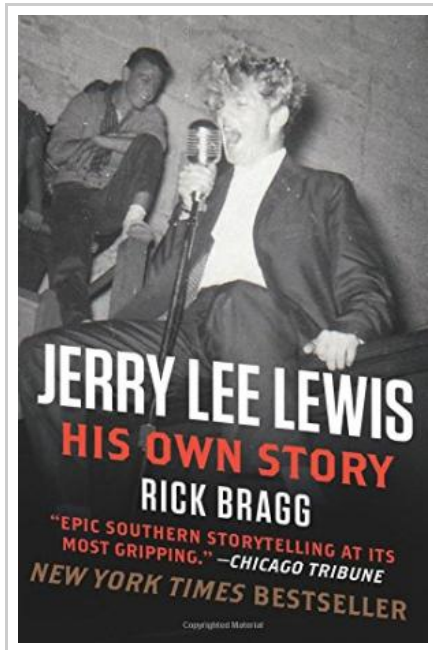




Jerry Lee Lewis: His Own Story (Paperback)
